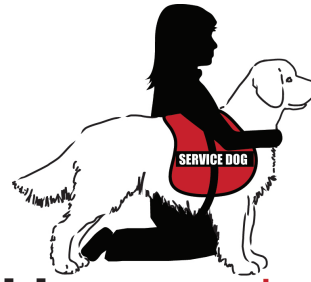

Application Guidelines and Instructions:

This competitive grant provides Community Resource Dogs to Norfolk County Police Departments. This extraordinary resource is particularly well-suited to the school setting and is instrumental in de-escalation, establishing trust and responding to trauma as experienced by school-aged children.

Four police departments in Norfolk County will be selected. Selection will be based upon the department's demonstration of capacity to care and house the dog, assign handler(s) to train with the dog, work collaboratively with community members and agencies and assume financial responsibility for feeding and caring for the dog (approximately \$6,000 annually).

Please submit with the application a letter which outlines your department's capacity to achieve the above.
