“A 29-year-old construction worker died today at South Shore Hospital after he was critically injured when a house under construction on Vine Street in Weymouth collapsed around noontime,” said Norfolk District Attorney Michael W. Morrissey.

District Attorney Morrissey identified the victim as Mario Diaz Obando of Fall River.

“Mr. Diaz Obando was one of five workers injured when the house collapsed. Four other workers suffered minor injuries and were transported to the hospital as well,” said Weymouth Police Chief Richard Fuller.

The incident remains under investigation by the United States Department of Labor Occupational Safety and Health Administration, the Massachusetts Department of Industrial Accidents, Weymouth Police, and the Massachusetts State Police assigned to the Norfolk District Attorney’s Office.
